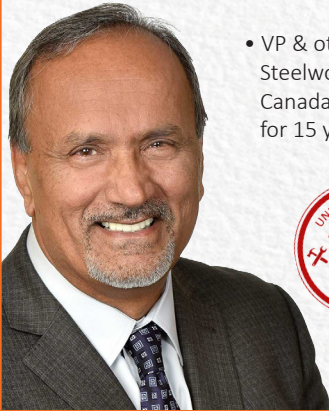

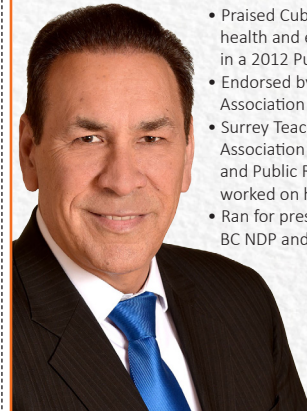

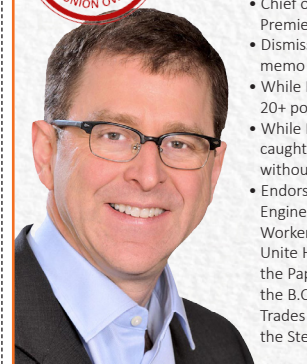

- While NDP leader, caught riding SkyTrain without a ticket
- Endorsed by the Operating Engineers, the B.C. Ferry Workers, the Labourers, Unite Here Local 40, COPE, the Paperworkers Union, the B.C. and Yukon Building Trades Council and the Steelworkers.

- Stapled \$10 bills to NDP membership forms during 2011 leadership race



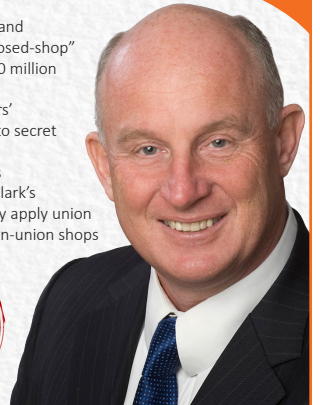
HORGAN'S ZEROES

- Voted to make Island Highway work "closed-shop" – put project \$500 million over budget
- Took away workers' democratic right to secret ballot in union certification votes
- Supported Glen Clark's plan to unilaterally apply union agreements to non-union shops

- Endorsed by New Westminster & District Labour Council



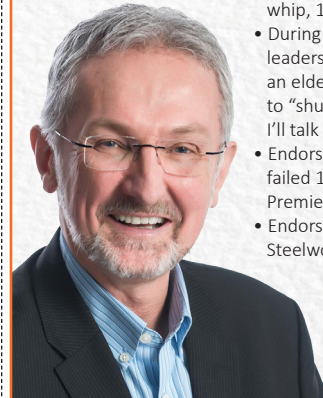
HORGAN'S ZEROES
